






A varied and balanced diet is essential to meet daily nutritient requiements. However, there is widespread deficiency of mironutrients in the country. Fortification of food with key vitamins and minerals is a useful complementary strategy to fill nutritional gaps in large sections of the population. Fortification does not change the texture, smell or taste of food or require change in behaviour, thus, making it easy to adopt. It is simple, scalable and cost-effective. An enabling ecosystem has been created to promote large-scale food fortification in Government safety net programmes and the open market across the country.
